

Skitube - Alpine Railway

Perisher's Skitube is a Swiss designed rack-rail train that takes passengers from Bullocks Flat Terminal on the Alpine Way through a tunnel in the Ramshead Range to the Perisher Resort. The first stop is the underground station at Perisher Valley and then continues on to Blue Cow through another tunnel through the Perisher Range.

When you arrive at Bullocks Flat Terminal, you'll find free day and overnight parking and because it is located below the snow fall levels, you generally won't require chains. You also don't need to purchase the National Parks entry fee.

Oversnow Transport

Matterhorn Lodge's oversnow transfers are conducted by 4-site Australia from the Perisher Skitube terminal building and are complimentary on arrival and departure (only) provided they are within 4-site's normal business hours of 7.30am until 8.30pm (10.30pm on Friday, Saturday and Tuesday) 7 days. There are no oversnow transport services outside these hours. When you arrive at the Perisher Skitube Terminal please report to the 4-site desk and book your transfer to Matterhorn Lodge – at the same time you will be asked to book your departure/return trip. Parking at Perisher

There is no Overnight Parking at Matterhorn Lodge. Vehicles can be left at Skitube terminal at Bullocks Flat or arrangements made with other transfer providers (see below).

Flying to the Snowy Mountains - Regional Express (Rex), in partnership with Snowy Mountains Airport Corporation Pty Ltd (SMAC), has launched Regular Public Transport (RPT) services between Sydney and the Snowy Mountains (Cooma)
